NABI Chasing the Sun Competition Pow Wow CONTESTANT RULES and GUIDELINES

In order to maintain the integrity of competition Pow Wow, the following must be adhered to by all contestants in the Chasing the Sun Pow Wow:

1. All contestants must be signed up no later than 11:00 am on Saturday, May 2, 2009. NO EXCEPTIONS.
2. All contestants are expected to participate in the Grand Entry at 7:00 pm on Friday, May 1, 2009. Points will be given.
3. All contestants must be ready when their category is called.
4. There is a zero tolerance on alcohol and drugs. Any dancer or participant in violation will be removed from the grounds immediately and will forfeit any prize money won.
5. The dance contest is on a point system (Grand Entry, Spot Checks, Contest Songs).
6. No family member will judge a contest in which a family member/relative is competing. This includes relation by blood, marriage or adoption. Dancer discovered to be dancing in such a scenario will be disqualified from that session.
7. Contestants must display their number on the front side visible to judges and tabulators.
8. Contestants are responsible for their numbers. Numbers loss or damaged must be reported to the Committee immediately.
9. Any major part of a contestant's regalia that falls or drops will result in the disqualification of that contestant for that session.
10. Contestants may enter in only one category and once registered, cannot switch categories.
11. Contestants must have full dance regalia to compete and regalia must be appropriate for the session in which they compete.
12. Monetary donations from spectators during the contest will disqualify the contestant for that session.
13. Official photographs taken by NABI Chasing the Sun 10k and Pow Wow can be used for future promotional purposes.
14. Winning payouts will be in check form. Any contestant winnings over \$600 will be required to complete and sign a W9 form; to include a valid Social Security # and must show proof of tribal enrollment to collect payouts. (C.I.B./Tribal Enrollment Card)
15. Contestants ONLY allowed in lower level locker rooms and contestant's lounge. Must have contestant wristband to enter.
16. Lost or stolen wristbands will NOT be replaced. Ticket purchase for re-entry.
